

# Chisomoka Hill

## Description:

The Chisomoka Bronze qualifier option takes place largely on the Zambezi Conservancy, in the Lower Zambezi Valley. Participants camp at the base of Chisomoka hill for the night. Chisomoka is a small but challenging hill in right on the edge of the escarpment. This is a wild camping experience, hike up the hill and an abseil down a steep rock face. Making it to the top of the hill provides a great sense of achievement as getting it to the summit is not easily achieved. However the breathtaking views of the escarpment and the valley from the top of the hill are well worth the climb. Assessment of the participants commences after arrival while they plan their routes and conduct their equipment checks and packing. On qualifying expeditions, participants are monitored and assessed but not supervised.

A typical 3 night qualifier programme includes:

- Day 1 – Travel to Wildtracks Lodge and half a day of planning and packing assessment
- Day 2 – Adventurous journey and camp out at the foot of Chisomoka Hill \*short bus ride to the start point from Wildtracks required.
- Day 3 – Adventurous journey ending in a celebration on an island in the Zambezi river and feast at Wildtracks Lodge.
- Day 4 – Depart after breakfast with a packed lunch.
