

Lusaka National Park

Description:

The Lusaka National Park boasts a collection of wildlife such as giraffe, impala, zebra, wildebeest and Thabo the white rhino. Participants enjoy two days of navigation, through a network of footpaths and bush tracks in the hope of seeing as many wild animals as possible. Throughout the duration of the expedition participants collect data on the animals and share that data with the Lusaka National Park staff with whom we share our vision of conservation education.

Training and supervision before the practice expedition includes *first aid, navigation and mapping, bush safety, camp craft and bush cooking, equipment checks and packing.*

On practice expeditions participants are supervised throughout by a qualified Award Leader.

A typical 3 day, 1 night practice programme includes:

- Day 1 – Training and preparation at school or venue of the school's choice in Lusaka.
- Day 2 – Drop off at Lusaka National Park for adventurous journey and camp out in a boma inside the Park.
- Day 3 – Adventurous journey completion and pickup from Lusaka National Park.

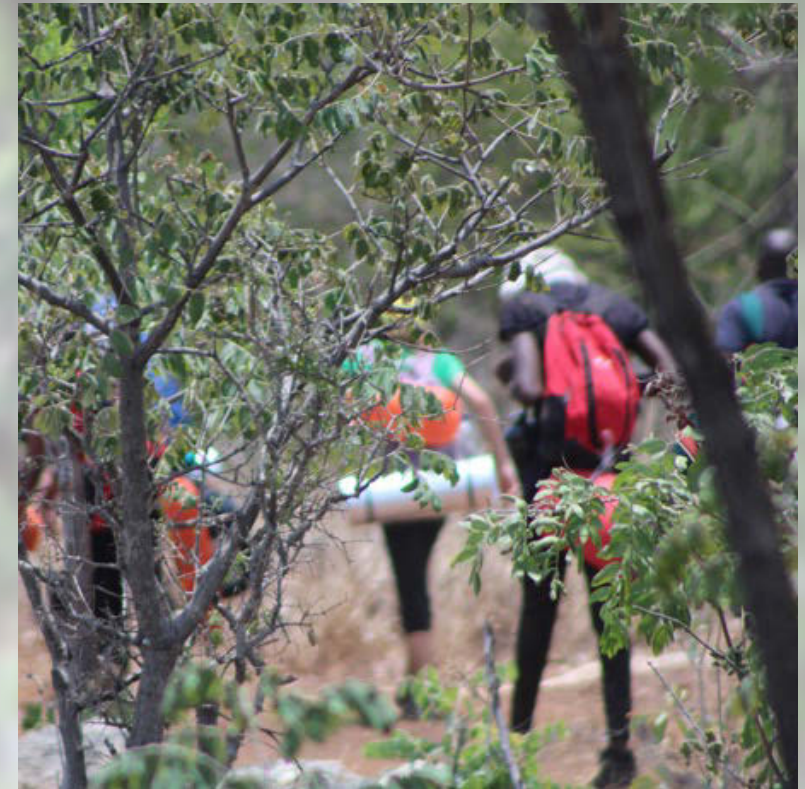
