

# Lusaka National Park

## Description:

The Lusaka National Park boasts a collection of wildlife such as giraffe, impala, zebra, wildebeest and Thabo the white rhino. Participants enjoy two days of navigation, through a network of footpaths and bush tracks in the hope of seeing as many wild animals as possible. Throughout the duration of the expedition participants collect data on the animals and share that data with the Lusaka National Park staff with whom we share a vision for conservation education.

Assessment of the participants commences at school while they plan their routes and conduct their equipment checks and packing. On qualifying expeditions, participants are monitored and assessed but not supervised.

A typical 3 day, 1 night qualifying programme includes:

- *Day 1* – Assessment of planning and packing at school or venue of the school's choice in Lusaka
- *Day 2* – Drop off at Lusaka National Park for adventurous journey and camp out in a secure boma inside the Park.
- *Day 3* – Adventurous journey completion and pickup from Lusaka National Park.
