

# Shikalomo to Zambezi

## Description:

The Shikaloma – Zambezi expedition begins on day one with a walking expedition through the Zambeef Conservancy to the remote village of Shikaloma. On day two the participants trek along the “lost road” down to the banks of the Zambezi River where they have to meet a boat pick up in time for a transfer to their island campsite for the night. On the last day of the expedition, participants navigate their way to Wildtracks Lodge, in time for a well deserved dip in the swimming pool and a celebratory feast to end of three challenging days of walking and navigation.

Assessment of the participants commences after arrival while they plan their routes and conduct their equipment checks and packing. On qualifying expeditions, participants are monitored and assessed but not supervised.

A typical 4 night qualifier programme includes:

**Day 1** – Travel to Wildtracks Lodge and half a day of planning and packing assessment

**Day 2** – Adventurous journey and camp out in Shikaloma \*short bus ride to the start point from Wildtracks required.

**Day 3** - Adventurous journey, boat pickup and camp out on an island in the Zambezi River

**Day 4** – Adventurous journey ending in a celebration feast at Wildtracks Lodge.

**Day 5** – Depart after breakfast with a packed lunch.
