

# Wildtracks Exploration

## Description:

Based on the Wildtracks Lodge property in Lower Zambezi valley, this adventurous journey is a learning experience for participants to explore the culture and lifestyle of the Gova people. Check points are manned by Instructors who have grown up in the area and are on hand to teach Participants how to make clay pots, cook Baobab tree porridge and sleep under a stunning grove of Baobab trees. There are also some activities along the way that will assess participants' survival skills and camp craft.

Assessment of the participants commences after arrival while they plan their routes and conduct their equipment checks and packing.

On qualifying expeditions, participants are monitored and assessed but not supervised.

A typical 3 night qualifier programme includes:

- *Day 1* – Travel to Wildtracks and half a day of planning and packing assessment.
- *Day 2* – Adventurous journey and camp out under the baobab trees.
- *Day 3* – Adventurous journey ending in a celebration on an island in the Zambezi river and feast at Wildtracks Lodge.
- *Day 4* – Depart after breakfast with a packed lunch.
